#### Pat Lencioni: Lessons from "The Advantage"

- Four key disciplines:
  - 1) Cohesive leadership team
  - 2) Create clarity
  - 3) Over-communicate clarity
  - 4) Reinforce clarity

# Pat Lencioni: Lessons from "The Advantage"

- Building a cohesive leadership team requires
  - 1) Trust
  - 2) Conflict
  - 3) Commitment
  - 4) Accountability
  - 5) Results

### Pat Lencioni: Lessons from "The Advantage"

- Hiring for fit—key characteristics to look for
  - 1) Humble
  - 2) Hungry
  - 3) Smart
- Take 2 out of 3, but don't leave out humility

#### Atul Gawande: Key themes in "Being Mortal"

- Modern experience of mortality
  - People fail "randomly and gradually"
  - Most die from long medical struggle—death certain, timing isn't
  - Just 17% die at home—used to be 85%
  - About half use Hospice, many fewer use Palliative Care
  - Families often not local—"intimacy at a distance"
  - Caregiver demands increasing as diagnoses shift
  - Too few geriatricians
  - Expanding institutional alternatives, but "just not home"

## Atul Gawande: Key themes in "Being Mortal"

- Biggest challenge: Despair
  - 1) Boredom
  - 2) Loneliness
  - 3) Helplessness
- Biggest risk: Falling –88% more likely if
  - 1) Poor balance
  - 2) 4+ meds routinely
  - 3) Muscle weakness

## Atul Gawande: Key themes in "Being Mortal"

- · Alternatives for improving care and quality of life
  - Objective: "Job is not to confine choices in name of safety, but to expand them in name of a worthwhile life...NOW"
  - More payor flexibility:
    - Patients reluctant to early adopt Hospice
    - · Curative AND Palliative Care needed
    - · Non-medical services
    - Payor risk limits interest: MA Plans
  - More support for staying at home
    - Hospital in a home—PHS, Marshfield Clinic
    - Pre-Acute Care vs Post Acute Care
    - Telehealth and related technology
